How to Apply a Sepia Tone to a Photo in Corel Photo-Paint

A sepia tone is a reddish brown monochrome tint. When applied to a photo, it gives the picture a warm, antique feeling. It's easy to do in Photo-Paint!

Here's How:

Open the image in Photo-Paint.
If the image is in color, go to Image > Adjust > Desaturate and skip to step 4.
If the image is in grayscale go to Image > Adjust > RGB Color.
Go to Image > Adjust > Color Hue.
Click on the slider at 0.
Click on More Yellow arrow.
Click on More Red arrow.
Click OK.

Tip:

Experiment in the Color Hue dialog to apply other color tints to your photos.

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
